The webinar aims to foster connections, cooperation among (deep and shallow) geothermal stakeholders in eight countries that are partly or wholly located in the Pannonian Basin: Austria, Croatia, Hungary, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia and the Ukraine.

The Pannonian Basin is rich in – underutilised – geothermal resources that can be critical in reducing import fossil fuel and other dependencies and fostering sustainable development. While it already features several European best practices in district heating, spas, greenhouses and other fields, a lot more could be achieved. There is significant project development activity that generates opportunities and needs for geothermal stakeholders.

One of the preconditions of progress is better awareness and connections among relevant stakeholders of various regions. This event aims to facilitate this in a structured manner. It can contribute to more effective and efficient business development activities of the participating geothermal stakeholders. There is a limited pool of qualified experts, potential project sponsors can have a better access to them via higher awareness provided.

People interested in participation are requested, by **29 May**, to share basic information via email to y.demchuk@geothermalukraine.org about their organisation, references, website and interests via email and shall give consent that this information is shared with the participants of the online event.

At the event, participants are requested to make a brief, 3-5 minutes presentation (maximum 5 slides including title slide) on their organisation and interests. Presentations are followed by a moderated Q&A session, based on questions asked by participants in the chat function.

Direct contact between interested participants can facilitate future cooperation in: (1) tender cooperation in EU calls, (2) finding partners for equipment or service sales, (3) finding partners for the realisation of specific planned geothermal investments, (4) joint technology or (cross-border, interregional) business development, market expansion (5) other areas.
